The Rock Island County Health Department reports 31 new COVID-19 cases, bringing the total number to 2,628. The total number of deaths in Rock Island County from this virus stands at 71. Currently, 14 patients are hospitalized in Rock Island County.

- 1 man in his 90s
- 2 men in their 80s
- 1 man in his 70s
- 3 men in their 60s
- 1 man in his 50s
- 5 men in their 20s
- 1 boy in his teens
- 2 boys younger than 10
- 1 woman in her 80s
- 2 women in their 70s
- 2 women in their 50s
- 2 women in their 40s
- 2 women in their 30s
- 1 woman in her 20s
- 3 women in their teens
- 1 girl in her teens
- 1 girl younger than 13

No additional information regarding these cases is available due to federal privacy laws.
