Rock Island County Health Department reports 13 new cases of COVID-19

The Rock Island County Health Department reports 13 new cases of COVID-19, bringing the total to 448 cases. Currently, 22 patients are hospitalized.

The new cases are:

- A man in his 40s who is being treated in a local hospital
- A man in his 70s who is isolating at home
- A man in his 50s who is isolating at home
- A man in his 30s who is isolating at home
- A male child younger than 1 who is isolating at home
- A woman in her 80s who is isolating at home
- A woman in her 80s who is isolating at home
- A woman in her 50s who is isolating at home
- A woman in her 50s who is isolating at home
- A woman in her 40s who is isolating at home
- A woman in her 20s who is isolating at home
- A woman in her 20s who is isolating at home
- A woman in her teens who is isolating at home

No additional information regarding these cases is available due to federal privacy laws.

Remember, you control how you respond to COVID-19:
