### **5 more people test positive for COVID-19 in Rock Island County**

The Rock Island County Health Department reports five new COVID-19 cases, bringing the total number to 570. The county's death toll from this virus stands at 18.

The new cases are:

- A man in his 60s who is isolating at home
- A man in his 30s who is isolating at home
- A man in his 20s who is isolating at home
- A boy younger than 10 years old who is isolating at home
- A girl younger than 10 years old who is isolating at home

No additional information regarding these cases is available due to federal privacy laws.

We all must continue to do our part to prevent further spread of COVID-19 by:

- Staying home as much as possible
- Keeping at least 6 feet between you and anyone else
- Washing your hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds each time and using hand sanitizer when washing your hands is not possible
- Covering coughs and sneezes with a tissue or into your elbow
- Wearing a face covering when you must go out for essential supplies
- Staying home when you are ill
