Rock Island County Health Department reports 18 new cases of COVID-19

The Rock Island County Health Department reports 18 new COVID-19 cases, bringing the total number to 2,885. Currently, 16 patients are hospitalized. The total number of deaths in Rock Island County from this virus stands at 75.

The new cases are:

- 1 man in his 70s
- 1 man in his 60s
- 2 men in their 50s
- 1 man in his 40s
- 1 man in his 30s
- 3 men in their 20s
- 2 women in their 60s
- 2 women in their 40s
- 1 woman in her 30s
- 2 women in their 20s
- 1 woman in her teens
- 1 girl younger than 13

No additional information regarding these cases is available due to federal privacy laws.

- Watching your distance and keeping at least 6 feet between you and anyone else
- Wearing a face covering when you must go out
