Rock Island County Health Department reports 21 new cases of COVID-19

The Rock Island County Health Department reports 21 new COVID-19 cases, bringing the total number to 3,274. Currently, 23 patients are hospitalized. The total number of deaths in Rock Island County from this virus stands at 85.

The new cases are:

- 2 women in their 80s
- 2 women in their 60s
- 2 women in their 50s
- 1 woman in her 40s
- 3 women in their 30s
- 2 women in their 20s
- 1 girl in her teens
- 1 man in his 50s
- 2 men in their 40s
- 3 men in their 20s
- 2 boys in their teens

No additional information regarding these cases is available due to federal privacy laws.

We all must continue to do our part to prevent further spread of COVID-19 by:

- Washing your hands frequently
- Watching your distance and keeping at least 6 feet between you and anyone else
- Wearing a face covering when you must go out
