**Rock Island County Health Department reports 32 new cases of COVID-19**

The Rock Island County Health Department reports 32 new COVID-19 cases, bringing the total number to 3,788. Currently, 25 patients are hospitalized in Rock Island County. The number of deaths from this virus stands at 97.

The new cases are:

- 1 woman in her 70s
- 1 woman in her 60s
- 6 women in their 50s
- 3 women in their 40s
- 6 women in their 30s
- 2 women in their 20s
- 1 woman in her teens
- 2 men in their 60s
- 3 men in their 50s
- 2 men in their 40s
- 3 men in their 30s
- 1 man in his 20s
- 1 male infant younger than 1

No additional information regarding these cases is available due to federal privacy laws.
