Rock Island County Health Department reports 104 new cases of COVID-19

The Rock Island County Health Department reports 104 new COVID-19 cases, bringing the total number to 6,709. Currently, 58 patients are hospitalized in the county. The death toll from this virus remains at 115.

The new cases are:

- 2 women in their 70s
- 5 women in their 60s
- 13 women in their 50s
- 8 women in their 40s
- 12 women in their 30s
- 12 women in their 20s
- 4 women in their teens
- 1 girl in her teens
- 4 girls younger than 13
- 7 men in their 70s
- 4 men in their 60s
- 6 men in their 50s
- 2 men in their 40s
- 7 men in their 30s
- 8 men in their 20s
- 3 men in their teens
- 4 boys in their teens
- 1 boy infant 1 or younger

No additional information regarding these cases is available due to federal privacy laws.
