The Rock Island County Health Department reports 40 new cases of COVID-19, bringing the total to 11,424 cases. Currently, 38 patients are hospitalized in the county. The total number of deaths from this virus stands at 279.

- 3 women in their 40s
- 1 woman in her 30s
- 7 women in their 20s
- 2 women in their teens
- 1 man in his 80s
- 3 men in their 60s
- 4 men in their 50s
- 1 man in his 40s
- 8 men in their 20s
- 1 man in his teens
- 2 boys younger than 13
