Rock Island County Health Department reports 45 new cases of COVID-19

The Rock Island County Health Department reports 45 new COVID-19 cases, bringing the total number to 13,457.

Currently, 15 patients are hospitalized with COVID-19 in Rock Island County. The number of deaths from this virus stands at 307.

The new cases are:

- 1 man in his 80s
- 3 men in their 60s
- 3 men in their 50s
- 4 men in their 40s
- 5 men in their 30s
- 1 man in his 20s
- 1 man in his teens
- 2 boys in their teens
- 2 boys younger than 13
- 2 boy infants 1 or younger
- 2 women in their 60s
- 1 woman in her 50s
- 2 women in their 40s
- 4 women in their 30s
- 2 women in their 20s
- 1 girl in her teens
- 9 girls younger than 13

No additional information regarding these cases is available due to federal privacy laws.

Remember, you control how you respond to COVID-19:
