Rock Island County Health Department reports 4 new cases of COVID-19

The Rock Island County Health Department reports four new cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 14,958. Currently, six patients are hospitalized in the county with the virus. The number of deaths remains at 328

The new cases are:

- 1 woman in her 70s
- 1 woman in her 40s
- 1 man in his 50s
- 1 boy younger than 13

No additional information regarding these cases is available due to federal privacy laws.

We all must continue to do our part to prevent further spread of COVID-19 by:

- Getting vaccinated as soon as you can. Visit [vaccines.gov](https://www.vaccines.gov) to find your shot. RICHD offers walk-in vaccines on Tuesdays (Moderna and Johnson & Johnson) and Fridays (Pfizer). The hours for both days are 9 a.m. to noon and 1-4 p.m.
- Staying home when you are sick
- Wearing a face covering if you have not been fully vaccinated
- Keeping 6 feet of physical distance from others in public if you have not been fully vaccinated.
- Washing your hands frequently
