**Rock Island County Health Department reports 57 new cases of COVID-19 over 2 days**

The Rock Island County Health Department reports 57 new cases of COVID-19 over two days: 25 on Friday and 32 on Saturday. The total number is now 12,601. Currently, 15 patients are hospitalized in the county with the virus. The number of deaths stands at 302.
