Rock Island County Health Department reports 27 new cases of COVID-19 over 2 days

The Rock Island County Health Department is reporting 27 new COVID-19 cases: 16 on Monday and 11 on Tuesday. The health department was closed on Monday for the Presidents Day holiday. The total number of cases is 12,647. Currently, 14 patients are hospitalized with COVID-19 in Rock Island County. The total number of deaths from this virus stands at 302.

The new cases are:

- 1 man in his 50s
- 2 men in their 40s
- 2 men in their 20s
- 1 boy in his teens
- 1 woman in her 50s
- 1 woman in her 40s
- 1 woman in her teens
- 1 girl in her teens
