Rock Island County Health Department reports 1 death, 46 new COVID-19 cases

The Rock Island County Health Department is reporting the COVID-19 death of a woman in her 90s. She had been living in a long-term-care facility. Her death brings the county's total to 311.

"We offer our sincere condolences to her loved ones," said Nita Ludwig, administrator of the Rock Island County Health Department.

The health department also is reporting 46 cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is now 13,860. Currently, 25 patients are hospitalized in the county with the virus.

The new cases are:

- 1 woman in her 70s
- 3 women in their 60s
- 2 women in their 50s
- 5 women in their 40s
- 3 women in their 30s
- 3 women in their 20s
- 1 woman in her teens
- 1 girl in her teens
- 5 girls younger than 13
- 1 man in his 70s
- 1 man in his 60s
- 1 man in his 50s
- 4 men in their 40s
- 4 men in their 30s
- 5 men in their 20s
- 1 man in his teens
- 3 boys in their teens
- 2 boys younger than 13

No additional information regarding these cases is available due to federal privacy laws.
