Rock Island County Health Department reports 41 new COVID-19 cases

The Rock Island County Health Department is reporting 41 cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is now 13,901. Currently, 21 patients are hospitalized in the county with the virus. The number of deaths stands at 311.

The new cases are:

- 1 man in his 80s
- 1 man in his 70s
- 3 men in their 50s
- 1 man in his 40s
- 5 men in their 30s
- 3 men in their 20s
- 2 men in their teens
- 3 boys in their teens
- 2 boys younger than 13
- 2 women in their 70s
- 2 women in their 60s
- 7 women in their 40s
- 6 women in their 30s
- 1 woman in her 20s
- 1 girl in her teens
- 1 girl infant 1 or younger

No additional information regarding these cases is available due to federal privacy laws.
