Rock Island County Health Department reports 25 new cases of COVID-19

The Rock Island County Health Department reports 25 new cases of COVID-19, bringing the total to 14,092. Currently, 18 patients are hospitalized in the county with the virus. The number of deaths remains at 311. The average age of today's cases is 32.

The new cases are:

- 1 woman in her 40s
- 3 women in their 30s
- 3 women in their 20s
- 1 woman in her teens
- 2 girls in their teens
- 1 girl younger than 13
- 1 man in his 60s
- 2 men in their 50s
- 7 men in their 40s
- 1 man in his teens
- 3 boys younger than 13

No additional information regarding these cases is available due to federal privacy laws.

We all must continue to do our part to prevent further spread of COVID-19 by:

- Getting vaccinated as soon as you can. Appointments are available through links at richd.org and the Rock Island County Health Department's Facebook's page.
- Staying home as much as possible and especially when you are sick
