**Rock Island County Health Department reports 64 new cases of COVID-19**

The Rock Island County Health Department reports 64 new cases of COVID-19, bringing the total to 14,326. Currently, 27 patients are hospitalized in the county with the virus. The number of deaths remains at 313. The average age of today's cases is 32.

The new cases are:

- 1 woman in her 70s
- 4 women in their 50s
- 11 women in their 40s
- 2 women in their 30s
- 4 women in their 20s
- 1 girl in teens
- 8 girls younger than 13
- 1 man in his 70s
- 3 men in their 60s
- 2 men in their 50s
- 7 men in their 40s
- 3 men in their 30s
- 7 men in their 20s
- 4 men in their teens
- 3 men in their teens
- 2 boys younger than 13
- 1 boy infant 1 or younger

No additional information regarding these cases is available due to federal privacy laws.
