**Rock Island County Health Department reports 2 new COVID-19 cases over 3 days**

The Rock Island County Health Department reports two new cases of COVID-19 since the last report on Friday. The total is now 14,998. Currently, one patient is hospitalized in the county with the virus. The total number of deaths remains at 333.

The new cases are:

- 1 woman in her 50s
- 1 woman in her 30s

No additional information regarding these cases is available due to federal privacy laws.

We all must continue to do our part to prevent further spread of COVID-19 by:

- Getting vaccinated as soon as you can. Visit [vaccines.gov](https://www.vaccines.gov) to find your shot. RICHD offers walk-in vaccines on Tuesdays (Moderna and Johnson & Johnson) and Fridays (Pfizer). The hours for both days are 9 a.m. to noon and 1-4 p.m.
- Staying home when you are sick
- Wearing a face covering if you have not been fully vaccinated
- Keeping 6 feet of physical distance from others in public if you have not been fully vaccinated
- Washing your hands frequently
