The Rock Island County Health Department reports one new case of COVID-19. The total number of cases is now 14,999. Currently, there are no patients hospitalized in the county with the virus. The total number of deaths remains at 333.

The new case is:

- A woman in her 50s

No additional information regarding the case is available due to federal privacy laws.

- Keeping 6 feet of physical distance from others in public if you have not been fully vaccinated
